Sewer Update

You will have two months to pay the \$3000.00 fee and also begin your monthly payment. Once you are hooked up and inspected then you start paying. A question was asked about how long you have to fill in your existing system. Permits to do this are not needed. Ed will ask about the time frame. Most of the grinders on East Shore Drive are completed. They are working on putting in the main line on West Shore Drive. Completion should be in September or October for the west side. There have been many more rocky areas to go through so this slows down the process. No green tags can be given out until the plant is working. The sewer system was not designed to handle storm run-off.
