Sewer Update

They will be giving out green tags starting on Monday or Tuesday. Once you see the green tag your line has been tested. This will begin on Billings Mill Road, Marina Drive, Cove Road and Indian Springs Road. In about two weeks they will begin testing on East Shore Drive. They hope to be done by the end of August. They have run into many trouble spots. Harger is installing the pumps and Lawson is doing the testing.

A question was asked, what is the next step after getting the green tag? You call your contractor to hook up, leave the hole open. Call Ty Dodge at 570-240-0024. He will inspect your system for any leaks. The Sewer Authority will mail you a form. Ty Dodge needs to sign this form, then you can begin to use the sewer, fill in your existing system and begin paying. The plant is up and running. It is unmanned but once a day a sample is taken. There was some discussion regarding the reclamation of your property where the grinder pump was installed. You can either wait for them to do this or do it yourself. If you have any questions call Becky at the Tunkhannock Township Building.
